GRNSW + LADBROKES MILLION DOLLAR CHASE - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

All owners and trainers who nominate their greyhounds for the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase race series are required to agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions of Entry available [here](#).

These FAQs are designed to assist owners and trainers to understand their obligations under the Terms and Conditions of Entry, but are not designed to replace those Terms and Conditions. Owners and Trainers should read the Terms and Conditions of Entry in full.

Who do the Terms and Conditions of Entry apply to?

The Terms and Conditions of Entry apply to all owners and trainers who nominate any greyhound for any race meeting which forms part of the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase and/or any Associated Events (including Masters Meteor, Young Star and Regional Reward events).

What are my obligations when my greyhound is retired?

All greyhounds competing in the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase and/or any Associated Events (including Masters Meteor, Young Star and Regional Reward events) must be kept by the owner as a companion animal, registered for breeding purposes or rehoming upon retirement.

If this obligation is not complied with, any prizemoney won by the greyhound must be immediately repaid to GRNSW.

Can I register my greyhound for breeding purposes upon retirement?

Yes. All greyhounds competing in the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase and/or any Associated Events (including Masters Meteor, Young Star and Regional Reward events) can either be kept by the owner as a companion animal, registered for breeding purposes or rehoming upon retirement.

How will the race meetings be conducted?

All race meetings for the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase and/or any Associated Events (including Masters Meteor, Young Star and Regional Reward events) will be conducted in accordance with the GWIC Greyhound Racing Rules, the GRNSW Grading Policy and the Terms and Conditions of Entry.

What entry fees are payable?

- \$60 (incl. GST) per greyhound for each Regional Heat, City Qualifier and/or Semi-Final
- \$110 (incl. GST) per greyhound for the Consolation Final
- \$550 (incl. GST) per greyhound for the Grand Final

Payment must be made over the phone or electronically. GRNSW will contact all nominators for payment.

What will the entry fees be used for?

100% of all entry fees will be donated by GRNSW to the NSW Greyhounds As Pets program.

How many times can I enter my greyhound?

Each eligible greyhound can be entered in only one Qualifying Final (Regional) and, if it does not qualify for the Semi-Finals, the greyhound can be entered in a Qualifying Final (City). Each eligible greyhound has unlimited entries to Qualifying Finals (City).

What is the race series timetable for the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase?

- Qualifying Finals (Regional) will be held at 11 Regional NSW tracks between 3 – 28 September 2018. 14 Qualifying Finals (City) will be held at Wentworth Park on 22 and 29 September and 6 October 2018.
- 8 Semi-Finals will be held at Wentworth Park on 12 October 2018.
- The Grand Final will be held at Wentworth Park on 20 October 2018.

What is the prizemoney for the Grand Final of the GRNSW + Ladbrokes Million Dollar Chase?

- First: \$1,000,000
- Second: \$100,000
- Third: \$45,000
- Fourth: \$15,000
- Fifth to eighth: \$10,000 each

What is the race series timetable for the Masters Meteor event?

- 4 heats will be held at Wentworth Park on 10 October 2018.
- The Grand Final will be held at Wentworth Park on 20 October 2018.

What is the prizemoney for the Grand Final of the Masters Meteor event?

- First: \$100,000
- Second: \$20,000
- Third: \$10,000
- Unplaced: \$500 each

What is the race series timetable for the Yong Star event?

- 4 heats will be held at Wentworth Park on 10 October 2018.
- The Grand Final will be held at Wentworth Park on 20 October 2018.

What is the prizemoney for the Grand Final of the Young Star event?

- First: \$25,000
- Second: \$5,000
- Third: \$2,500
- Unplaced: \$500 each

What is the timetable for the Regional Reward event?

The Regional Reward will be held at Wentworth Park on 20 October 2018.

What is the prizemoney for the Grand Final of the Regional Reward?

- First: \$10,000
- Second: \$2,000
- Third: \$1,500
- Unplaced: \$500 each
