

GREYHOUNDS AS PETS (GAP) REHOMING – OWNER INCENTIVE SCHEME FORM

Under this scheme, owners of greyhounds registered with GWIC who retire a greyhound and intend to keep their greyhound as a pet or rehome the greyhound to family or friends, can apply to have their greyhound entered into the scheme using this form. The scheme provides funding for the greyhound to have a veterinary check, be desexed and have any minor dental work carried out.

There are two options for payment to be made under the scheme. The veterinarian performing the procedures can invoice GAP directly or the owner of the greyhound can pay the veterinarian and claim a reimbursement from GRNSW. This scheme application form provides details for both options in Part D below.

Greyhounds as Pets (GAP) Rehoming - Owner Incentive Scheme

Terms and Conditions

Owners:

By entering your greyhound in to the Owner Incentive Scheme, you accept and agree to the following terms and conditions. Please read them carefully.

1. You are authorised to present the greyhound for the treatment and procedures contemplated under the scheme.
2. Under the scheme your greyhound will undergo a physical examination, a desexing procedure (if required) and receive a dental care procedure (if required, as assessed by the veterinarian) at a licenced veterinary hospital in NSW.
3. Under the scheme the total amount payable is capped as follows:
 - consultation and desexing \$450
 - dental treatment \$200
4. Payments above the cap may be made in certain circumstances involving surgical complications. In such cases details of the surgical complication must be provided by the attending veterinarian and payments are made at the discretion of the GRNSW Chief Veterinary Officer.
5. GAP (or GRNSW) will not be responsible for any veterinary treatment costs beyond the procedures and treatment covered under the scheme (see 2 above).
6. You will be responsible for making the necessary arrangements with a veterinary hospital of your choice for the procedures to be carried out.
7. You are responsible for making an assessment of the suitability of the greyhound to the environment, people and other animals (pets) in the new home. Your greyhound will not be required to have a behavioural assessment by GAP however arrangements can be made to have a behavioural assessment by GAP should you choose to do so. In that case the desexing can be carried out prior to the behaviour assessment.
8. Rehomed greyhounds are required to be registered and be entered on the NSW Companion Animal Register (CAR). In NSW once off lifetime registration applies. By participating in the scheme and rehoming your greyhound you agree to advise the new owner that they will be required to register the greyhound and have it entered onto the CAR. You also agree to provide them with the greyhound's details and a copy of the desexing certificate to assist the registration process. Details of how to register a dog and have it entered on the CAR are available from your local government Council.
9. By participating in this scheme you are officially retiring the greyhound identified on this form and you are responsible for notifying the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission (GWIC) that the greyhound is retired using the appropriate form. 10. It is permissible to relinquish the greyhound to a rehoming agency if the circumstances change after you have rehomed the greyhound however no further claims of rehoming assistance from GAP can be made by you as the owner, any new owner or the rehoming agency in relation to the particular greyhound.
11. By entering your greyhound in to the Owner Incentive Scheme, you understand, that GRNSW and GAP reserve the right to refuse your greyhound entrance in to the Scheme.
